**INTRODUCTION:**

Therefore he travelled to England in 1975, and since then, he did his best to gain knowledge, he lived with an English family and then became a member of the Institute of

marketing in maidenhead in Britain, and a member of the American Management Association in Brussels.

He then was appointed Area Manager of Gulf Air in Qatar and made Doha office to be number one revenue generating among all in the world.

Productivity and on time performance improved and in efficiency also he became on the top. Then, he became a businessman and secured a guaranteed profit. Hassan Aljefairi is an activist, he always comes with new ideas, but because he is liberal and open minded, a lot of people are still getting angry with him, but some brave persons support him and agree that he is the voice of democracy in Qatar, the liberal, the man of peace who is fighting aggressively every day for quality education for the children in Qatar and for empowering women.

I blame the bad roads for the death of my son fahad in a car accident, people in Qatar die every week due to the bad condition of the roads. Most of these are needless deaths if the roads were better designed. Here in Qatar, we have more mistakes in the roads, this is why the rate of death due to car accident is the highest in the world, we could enter the Guinness world book of records for this.

Most of children at schools in Qatar are not being taught how to be good pedestrians and good passengers. That is why when they become adults, they can not be good drivers.

My son fahad was not driving, he was sitting next to his friend who was driving, another car came suddenly passing by another car opposite to them, facing fahad's car, forcing them to go off the road and hit another car, face to face, causing the death of six Qataris, among them my innocent son fahad who was at the time of his death 20 years old, he was one of the best students in Carnegie Mellon University in Qatar, his marks were excellent.

Drivers in Qatar are not being educated from the age of five, Roads are bad, leading drivers to make mistakes and due to bad Arabic education system in Doha, people do not pay attention to safety aspects, only Hassan Aljefairi alone writes and speaks every now and then about the importance to teach children safety at schools and to teach people at work.

Qatar Government does not support me and make me appear in the media and local press, instead they hide me, they say that I am causing for them embarrassment and shame, but only when a person famous dies in a car accident then they would pay some attention to safety.

When it comes to debates, I am not wanted; they want only those who support the Government to debate, those who usually say good things. I am not being encouraged to participate in seminars and lectures.

They do not want me to highlight some problems that they want to hide. My skills worry them and they are scared from my persuasion techniques. People can participate and talk freely about America and Israel, but I am not welcome, because I talk about our sufferings in Qatar. Every body knows that if Hassan Aljefairi wants to speak, then there is something wrong is happening somewhere in Qatar.

Youth are also getting angry with me; I accused them in Qatar University that their driving is inefficient. Students do not need large 4x4 four wheels drive cars, these large cars are designed for families. I told them to drive smaller cars that are designed for singles. Large cars are consuming more fuel and damaging the environment. I also do not want to see an idiot sitting with one hand on the top of the wheel racing along. They think that when they drive larger vehicles, then they are safer in the road that is wrong.

I asked the Qatari Government to introduce environment taxes and restrictions on large cars that are polluting the air, but instead, I was thrown out of the lecture rooms.

I am not upset of being thrown out, I am Hassan Aljefairi the Qatari activist, of course, I cannot expect that my

road to peace and love will be always full of roses and carnations. I threatened them to ask to impose congestion charges on large cars together with higher parking charges, but I was asked not to send them letters any more, but of course I love my people, the Qatari people, the people who do not know that large cars are twice likely to kill pedestrians and drivers in an accident as normal cars.

I am Hassan Aljefairi not interested to eat and sleep like an idiot and going o.k., I am going to do my best to build a new Qatar and I shall see you guys later. I meet foreign expatriates from different nationalities living in Qatar nearly everyday. I treat them good and with respect, why not? Am I not Hassan Aljefairi the ambassador, representing the non Government society? If I say something, then it has to be of benefit to everyone.

They are saying that I have got the monopoly of being the most active Qatari, fights with understanding and knowledge, the Qatari citizen who hates killing and violence.

Indeed, I am the favourite to my people, not even one rejected my mission, and to my Government that allows me to exceed the limits.

If you think what I write is nonsense, go and ask the embassies of the

most civilized countries in the world U.S.A, U.K and France, they will answer you, yes, he is Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari man of peace, sure, he is our friend, and he is also the best of the best. Why not? Am I not the voice of democracy in Qatar that promotes equal opportunities, free media and freedom of speech?

If you work hard for peace and love like what Hassan does, they will love you too. I am also the favourite citizen to H.H.Sheikh Hamad, the Emir of Qatar, and if you do not believe me, go to his office in the corniche, next to the clock tower, near where I was born, his doors are open, he will tell, yes, for sure, Hassan is the son of Qatar, he is our son.



I get angry with children sometimes and I say why do not you know anything about me, I am Hassan Aljefairi, who fights for a quality education for you, I explained that output of condensate and natural gas liquids(NGLs) is rising faster than oil. Output of these hydrocarbons and valuable liquids that are used to make chemicals and gasoline has risen rapidly and will compete with crude oil and will impact the oil price, therefore if you children want a good future, then learn English, Maths and Science, so you could join the best American and British Universities, that is the way to the future. They said Mr. Hassan, NGLs?, Hydrocarbons, what are you talking about?

Adults are also getting angry with me, when I say stop blaming the west for your ills, if you want to build good roads, schools or hospitals, then the western world will not stop you, stop blaming others for your home grown backwardness.

If the media is on my side, then I can maintain Local support.

Extremists can get all the space that they want in the Qatari Press and media, therefore they defeat me easily, but there is a social change that has to come to the Qatari society and sure this change will come on the hands of Hassan, but I am working alone, therefore, friends can not hide their friendship any more, friends of Hassan have got to work with him together, he needs all the support and co-ordination.

When Hassan talks about change, that means social change, empowering women, co-education and modern Qatar. Some people are accusing me for blaming the Qatari government for any problem, that is not true, for example, I do not blame it for the loss of billions of US\$ that was made through the sovereign funds. That is a global financial crisis that hit all countries in the world. Saudi, Kuwait and Abu Dhabi also had injected in to their sovereign wealth funds huge returns from oil income in order to maintain their total assets value. Why should I accuse Qatari Government for a situation that was not their fault?

However, in the short term, Qatar can sell the shares with 20% profit, or otherwise in the long term, I am optimistic that world economy will be on the mend, but not before 2012. That is what I am doing with my investment. Money is

important, but what more important is that Hassan is the oxygen of freedom in Qatar, and if anyone wants to breath the freedom under the sun light of the sky of Qatar, then the spirit of Hassan is there in the air.

I also agree with the Government for joining GCC countries to seek assistance from International Atomic Energy Agency with regard to both the feasibility of introducing nuclear power for electricity generation, sea water desalination and other peaceful purposes, but I disagree with Qatar Government on how to deal with water. Huge amount of desalinated sea water is being produced every day, but big percentage of such fresh water is being wasted through either a leakage under the ground, or by the misuse and over consume of water by the residents and the Government itself.

Also, if Qatari writers want to write with a style similar to Aljefairi's then sure, they will not be appointed to work in the Local Press or at Qatar News Agency. I created to myself so many enemies when I asked to close down Qatar News Agency. I personally believe that there is no need for such Agency to exist. Their work can be done by the news department in the Television and Radio Corporation. Some Engineers coming to Qatar to build our roads and houses, but these News Agency staff, every body wonders, what they are doing?

Local media institutions in Qatar do not want citizens like Hassan Aljefairi to work for them. They want some one to sit like a parrot and repeat what they say to him. Young Qatari journalists also do not know what is happening, they are too young to know. They are not so many, not everybody wants to become a parrot.

Owners of the Qatari media and press, do not want Qataries to interfere in what is happening in Qatar, especially with anything related to Government budget and public money, why would they want to be questioned by Hassan? Even though, I want the best for this Government, but

officials continue to receive their salaries every month, so they do not care if that is the best or not the best.

For example, I did a self study related to the health care sector and I suggested some changes especially those that are related to privatization. I recommended to establish a medical city that supports private investors to build hospitals, clinics, laboratories and then to request big businesses to shift their patients to the private health centres. That will reduce the burden on the public health sector and will reduce costs. That will enable government hospitals to provide higher quality health services to a fewer number of people. Instead of thanking me, giving me awards and appreciate what I am doing for them, their press isolated me, they banned my books, refused me entry to conferences and sent viruses to attack my website [www.hassanAljefairi.com](http://www.hassanAljefairi.com).

in Doha and other cities, the place looks as it is a military camp, due to this situation, less travellers come to Qatar, Hotel occupancy will be down, also Load factor of Airlines will be lower and less number of passengers will arrive in Doha, that situation would cause unemployment among Qataris, but signs of recovery will be hard to see.

Companies in the Private sector will be reluctant to employ Qataris due to weak economy. Only if Qatar Government chooses to be on the side of Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari liberal, then employers will feel confident that the economy is really growing, but if the fanatics become more influential, then companies will become anxious about growth as long as fanatics are in control.

How ever I am still optimistic. I am waiting for the constitutional court to start up. Perhaps, after I raise my case to them, they would pass a court order to hang the medals of bravery around my neck and stick stars of championship on my shoulders and chest.

However I am some times deliberately using hot language to test the level of democracy in Qatar. If they still let me speak, then it is not so bad. I am the liberal opposition activist Hassan, therefore Qatar Government faces test, when they let me write my letters, they pass, but when they refuse to give me the license to print and publish my book "Hassan Aljefairi's Diary", they fail the test.

I feel sorry for this Government, because they have no other choice, either Hassan, where the economic growth and prosperity is, or otherwise they can choose those radicals who separate men from women, then their trade and business will suffer from illness.

Extremists now are more influential in Qatar, there fore, the Government issuing more Visas for males only to work in Qatar, but less number of Visas are issued to single females. That is why when tourists and visitors drive around

If Hassan is ignored, more youth will be without work. Sources of easy money will be dried up. For some Qataris who are going to graduate next year. I do not see signs of light at the end of the tunnel, unless Government says yes to Aljefairi and becomes a free and open minded, otherwise suffering will continue and layoffs will be severe.

Even in education and health services, faster growing areas can not employ Qataris as they are not trained for such careers.

There are some who support me. Some nice young men and women signed together with a brave intelligent person showing their support and friendship to me. They called themselves Hassan Aljefairi fan on the face book.

With their launch of Hassan Aljefairi fan on face book, I felt much happier to see 51 young intelligent persons appreciate my fight for a better future for youth. They really made my day.

Qatar lifted censorship of news paper, but Press is owned by Government officials or their friends and relatives. These owners do not want Hassan Aljefairi to write in their news papers. They do not want sensitive stories. Despite of



constitutional guarantees of a free media, some ex ministry of Information Government officials were appointed as editors in chief. Letters that are being received from Hassan Aljefairi will end up in the dustbin. Here in Qatar, in order to write for a news paper, you have to obey the Government. It is important to have a free press, but in reality, we do not have it. Qatar is due to hold national elections next year, if you criticize, you will be isolated by the media, you will sure fail.

I had a column in a Qatari Arabic news paper three times a week, when I criticized Qatar Airways, I was stopped writing, until today not even one Arabic or English Qatari news paper agrees to publish for me. When I attend conferences and forums, the next day I am not in the news paper, they cut my name, my face and my talk.

If the ideology of Hassan Aljefairi becomes more popular among people specially the young, then this means that the Ideology of AlQaeda is in decline. At least Hassan Aljefairi is opposing the killing of innocent civilians, but AlQaeda is still able to recruit and able to raise money, some say through charities.

Quality education is not given to Qatari youth, there fore Government in the future has to budget emergency funds for jobless youth.

The young will be the first victims of bad education given to Qatari children under Arabic curriculum, there fore they should be given additional scholarships and job programmes.

Our young were also brain washed with an overdose of traditions, culture and extreme religious restrictions, that is why they feel that Hotels, leisure, entertainment, airlines and Airports are not the right places for them to work.

Our young will be isolated from customer services, public relations advertising and promotion services. They all want Government office job, but there are no jobs vacant waiting for every body. When I write to tackle the pain of the

young, the media and press hide my voice and pen, but because of them, every body in Qatar will suffer.

Some European countries will have to double their renewable energy capacity and are now investing billions of U. S. Dollars to meet the European Union's climate change target for 2020.

This means that demand on oil will be less, so Qatar has to give English education to children now, so they can have a better life afterwards.

In their efforts to productively utilize the school closure for one week on 27, sept, 2009, ordered by Government on the basis of HINI flu scare, some teachers of American school of Doha are recording their classes on video and providing them to students, but I have not heard that any Arab teachers in Arabic schools did the same, that is why I want to see Qataris children studying in International English curriculum primary schools, the quality is different and care is not the same.

Some of our female students are being deprived from the right to play sports at government and Independent schools. Sports are must, but some schools are not taking it seriously. Usually the class of sports is given to another teacher who was absent on the previous day or girls are asked to sit in the classroom or wander around in the school.

That is how our girls start gaining weight and then continue with the same in the early decades of adulthood dramatically reduce their chances of reaching old age in good health.

The more weight that women gain for lack of activity at work and at home, the less their chance of healthy survival.

It is important to maintain a healthy weight from early adulthood.

I am Hassan AlJefairi, a man of peace, but Israel does not want peace, I do not mind to see Israeli Defense Minister Ehud Barak arrested in Britain or some where else. There are allegations of war crimes committed by its forces in Gaza. An investigation is needed. Activists say that as per Geneva Convention, Barak should be arrested for war crimes. Still,

until now, humanitarian situation in Gaza deteriorating very badly.

Goldstone's report urges the UN Security Council to refer the allegations to the International criminal court if either Israel or Palestinian authorities fail to investigate and prosecute those suspect of such crimes within six months. The council is due to consider a resolution condemning Israel's failure to cooperate. Hassan Aljefairi will not forgive the International community if the criminals are left without punishment.

I am calling for accountability; no one should undermine International justice. I also publicly denounce any attack that target or indiscriminately harm civilians.

Let us talk about the health system in Qatar that is in the hands of some bureaucrats. I asked them to support the private health sector that in return will reduce the burden imposed on the head of public health section. The main problem is the misuse of the drugs that so much of medicines are being smuggled out of the country or end up in the dustbin.

Patients routinely arrive in Hamad Hospital emergency room complaining of a headache and asking for scan. Overuse of tests and drugs that have little value to the patients and can cause serious risk.

Due to the lack of support to the private health sector, Government hospitals have to deal with an increasing number of patients, and the waittime particularly for specialists may stretch for weeks or months. There is not enough care for Qataris but too much for their friends.

Another problem is that people with insurance plans can face life threatening complications from unnecessary care, back surgeries that result in wound infections, when physical therapy might have been a more effective treatment, having scans that expose patients to radiation, medication caused side effects that must be treated.

The misuse and overuse of drugs from simple antibiotics to sophisticated surgeries, Billions are spent on inappropriate drugs and treating non urgent cases in the emergency department.

Supporting the private health sector is one of the means to diversify the economy. Diversification is the key to

growth in Qatar, but as I said, there is always something wrong will be going on, but what we need is good rules and procedures.

So, Hassan Aljefairi says: quality education is required for our children, otherwise, if they graduate and be unemployed, there will be riots in the streets in which shops and restaurants will be smashed. This will be a case that shows the challenge for the government to create jobs and offer social space for a young population in the richest state in the world. A state that cannot continue with a system that has no parliament and that protests are banned. Young will search for the liberal, Hassan AlJefairi to support, because life for those extremists who use religion to make money and power won't be the same after economy downturn.



Qatar Government should regulate drug prices and fees for lab tests and medical services. It also should require patients to share some costs, so they have an incentive to avoid unnecessary treatments.

Good doctors should have comfortable life in Qatar so more are encouraged to work here.

Participants in the conference asked me wondering, Mr. Hassan AlJefairi, Are you a doctor? I said no, you do not have to be a doctor to become a director, I am a Qatari leader, and sure I am a man of policies and strategies. It is very simple, patients who do not want to be in the long waiting list, can share part of the cost, I said. That applies on non urgent medical cases.

Patients should enjoy the freedom of choice and access that the private system provides.

Private medical firms should be squeezed by both government regulators and Insurance companies to hold down costs.

Doctors and firms can receive warnings from Insurance companies that they prescribe too many drugs or expensive procedures.

If doctors cannot justify their treatments, they can be forced to repay insurers for a portion of the medical services that they prescribed. Patients have to pay the difference if they ask for brand name drugs or choose expensive doctors.

I am Hassan AlJefairi who said employers and employees should share the cost to limit the misuse and overuse.

Specialists sometimes can be rewarded and be paid on a fee-for-service basis, rather than on salary.

Specialists must earn at least 5 times more than the nation's average wage. General practitioners are to make 3 times more than the average wage. Insurers have enough power to use their muscle with physicians.

I asked the participants, can you imagine how much Qatar lost for not allowing me to speak and write? Am I not Hassan AlJefairi the oxygen of freedom in Qatar? They smiled and applauded.

Talk radio can be one of Hassan Aljefairi's achievements in Qatar, a lot of people will be excited to listen to educational programmes that can advance their knowledge and can be a great resource for values that I promote. Not only values but my wishes that all Governments work to stop the spread of

atomic weapons and free the planet of nuclear arms. One bomb can kill hundreds of thousands.

Efforts have to be made to prevent the extremists in Pakistan to have access to the Pakistani atomic weapons that is why that all nations should increase non military aid to Pakistani Government in order to build trust and cooperation with the Pakistani Army against extremism. There should be a long term commitment to help Pakistan by using economic development to battle the poverty that fuels extremism.

I have been always saying that diversification is the key to growth in Qatar, therefore, investment in education is the key to meet the requirements of the labour market. Oil and Gas prices can fall down any time due to the huge funds invested in the plans for renewable energy. If the visibility of any investment in alternative energy is proved, then investment authorities will not hesitate to pump billions of dollars in such renewable energy sectors.

The economy of Qatar has not been diversified the way Hassan Aljefairi wanted, there is no enough support to the tourism industry, reexport business is not there, industry is limited and free Zone is too small. That is exactly opposite to what I am asking for.

I am asking for quality English education to be given to our Qatari children that will enable them to enter the labour market after ten years from now.

Children of Government officials and children of the staff working for Qatar foundation are enjoying quality education in Qatar Academy while forty Qatari children are squeezed in one class room in some Government

independent schools. Whenever I raise this issue and start complaining about it, they accuse me of being a trouble maker. Qatari students should study Maths and Science on the hands of Native English speaking teachers so they can be graduated and join Universities to learn subjects that are required by the job market.

Qatari Government should reward Hassan Aljefairi for pressing for joint partnership between the private and the public sectors of both education and health, but unfortunately some officials are still not that educated enough to understand the mission of Hassan.
