Hassan Al Jefairi diary - Book 2

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#### **INTRODUCTION:-**

I am not welcome to write in the local Qatari Press because I ask so many questions like why many rush out of Qatar during holidays while only very few in return travel from abroad to Doha. That means



that there is a problem somewhere, like for example there are four males for every one female here in Qatar, there are so many men, it is like being in a military camp.

The new income tax law issued recently in Qatar to encourage more foreign investors to set up businesses in the country did not work to the standard required. That is due to lack of personal freedom in Qatar. That is why investors would rather to live abroad and service the market from outside. When they found out that I was liberal and this is my belief, they stopped me writing.

Everyone in Qatar knows that Hassan Al Jefairi is also not being welcome in conferences and seminars, because he is calling for educational policies that ensure access for all to good quality education. In Qatar, foreign children of expatriates and children of the Qatari Government officials enjoy quality education in Qatar academy, debakey, London, Sherborne, Doha College, DESS and American Schools while majority of Qatari children are given out of date Arabic education together with an overdose of religion and traditions in Arabic curriculum schools. That is why I am not being welcome, I always say that Qatar is a rich country, therefore we can afford to enroll each Qatari child to an English curriculum school to study

Maths and Science so he can become a doctor or engineer. There are so many inequalities in education. Qatari children are not enjoying quality in all levels, therefore, they do not have the skills to benefit from higher education in Weillcornell for example.

There is a big Qatari public money invested in quality primary and secondary English curriculum schools, but majority of Qatari students are deprived from the right to enjoy the quality education in such schools. Qatari pupils obtained a low score in international competitive examinations.

I always say that there are more investments made in education by Qatari Government for foreign students in Qatar Foundation, but much less money invested for Qatari students in Qatar University, that is why I am

Hassan AlJefairi, being isolated from the Qatari Press and Media. I support the call for globalization of curriculum, international exchange programmes and developing sense of respect for diverse culture among students. Globalization of Education means preparing students for a global economy.



Qatar opened up the internet use, but Qatari students English language is still poor, that is why they are not benefiting from the information that flows freely.

I am not any more welcome in the Doha debates in Qatar foundation. Tim Sebestian lately did not want me to talk. I raised my hand until my arm tired, but he insisted to avoid me allowing all foreigners to talk, while I am being a Qatari in my own country, but cannot talk, especially when he came to know that I was asking for expanded political freedoms in Qatar, seeking to get around Qatar's media curbs against me, to open up internet use and support non-censorship. Due to these values, I was suffering every time I attended the last four debates. I insisted that the more freedoms Qataris have, the stronger Qatari society becomes.

Ex-media officials were appointed as chief editors for Qatari local news papers. When they heard about me, Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari activist, trying to promote internet freedoms, they all decided to hide my hot pen.

It is unclear how many Qatari people know about Hassan Aljefairi, as many did not see me talking, as my speech is not televised nationally on Qatar T.V., though was shown sometimes on Aljazeera live channel, but only very small number of Qatari people watch it. They watch Aljazeera news channel, but not Aljazeera live channel.



My talk is not even mentioned in the local Qatar radio, neither in the local Arabic press nor the English news papers, because I am always calling for the observance of universal rights of political expression, free information everywhere, but not to use religion to gain money and power.

They want to a stop me standing up for promoting human rights in Qatar that we are all equal towards the law and that we all have access to equal opportunities. I am also being isolated due to the fact that I insist on enrolling thousands of Qatari students at U. S. Universities so the number can shot to a record high. Emerging economies like china, India and Vietnam sending thousands of students to U.S. while thousands of Qatari students are stranded in Qatar University learning back dated Social Studies and religion.

#### Friday 18 December 2009

There is no need to buy guns and weapons from U. S., instead we can be a strong engine to fuel the U.S. economy by sending more student. Qatar should put aside great students to study in U.S. and U.K.



#### Saturday19 December2009

Qatar has a very weak civil society, when I identify myself as a human rights activist, I am being ignored or denied entry to many forums and conferences. The committee that organizes conferences for the Ministry of foreign affairs allows foreign ordinary persons to participate only to fill the empty seats but refusing to allow me to enter the conferences halls. Human rights committee in Qatar, friends of the Environment Centre and other societies like the Doha centre for freedom of media cannot call themselves non-government civil society because they are government. They are being financed, paid and appointed by the Government. Such political and institutional structure is seriously harming the effectiveness of anti corruption efforts made by Hassan Aljefairi the undersigned. Only the Government of Qatar alone is able to strengthen the presence of Hassan Aljefairi as a civil society activist. They can easily instruct the media and press to allow me to appear. It is their media, their press and their conferences. It is their money, but the truth is that it is our money not only theirs.

I wrote many times to Qatar University to allow students boys and girls to study and socialize together. Girls do not have to cover up and wear the

black gown called an Abaya inside the campus. Those who try to stop Hassan Aljefairi to modernize Qatar University are not conservative forces but extremists and radicals beyond its walls and inside the campus trying to separate men from woman. Some are using Islam to gain influence in the University. The Qatari Government should not bow to the fanatics. But the Government is empowering religious extremists by giving them more presence and voice in media, press and seminars, while at the same time silencing Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari liberal, voice of Democracy in Qatar whom without freedom dies.

My voice that is calling for opening up is being cut, when I raise my hand asking for permission to talk in the Doha Debates, I am not being chosen by Tim Sebestian.

Many students in Qatar University are given a curriculum that is consistent with Islam. The Qatari Government whose political base has been the nation's strict religious, supports radicals on the expense of the liberal, Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari activist.



Many Qataris and expatriates when having to take a time off, they fly to Dubai, they do not want to stay in Qatar, that is why our hotels, towers and buildings are becoming like ghost houses.

Many students travel from abroad, coming to study in Qatar University, only because of free accommodation and free food, their tuition is waived and is given pocket money.

They said that it was not possible to bring change from outside, therefore, I, Hassan Aljefairi decided to build it from within, I asked for a program to meet the future labor market needs in Oatar. I have been accused of liberalizing and modernizing Qatar, but in reality, I could not make a change, not because I was less active, but due to the fact that the media and the press were not on my side. It was not my failure, it is their failure. I could have been more effective if the Government would have given me more space and presence. I want the people of Qatar to live a more western life.

Qatar has a citizen called Hassan Aljefairi who is willing to take the furthest step, but the Government does not want.

Without Hassan Aljefairi, Doha and other towns in Qatar will struggle as big employers will shut shops. Business will be awful, phones will not ring for hours, but if I am allowed to appear, write and talk, then business will boom and those phones will be ringing continuously and then you all will not keep up with orders. That local press that hides Aljefairi will make your business dead. Your companies will be hammered by them. Vote for Hassan Aljefairi or otherwise your establishments will close, you will have to cut down your staff and many of you will lose jobs.



Be like Aljefairi debt free, and then you will be able to hang on, you can hold on forever.

Without Aljefairi, your revenue will fall, that will hit your services from schools and health care to roads and bridges- you will suffer from unemployment and your youth will be hopeless. Vote for Aljefairi so you could feel the signs of the recovery Qatari economy.

### Sunday 20 DECEMBER 2009

Qatar plans to see its dream railway project ready by 2022. Dubai had completed its railways project in 2008.

That means we are 14 years backward from Dubai.

The success of an economy depends on its political stability. I told that young Qatari girl, the student who was attending one seminar, vote for Hassan Aljefairi whom without the economy slows. Aljefairi can diversify the economy, builds re- export, free zone and tourism industries that will provide you with entertainment.

Freedom can make happiness and can build positive emotion. You will be able to experience pleasure by being free to say what you want to say. If you vote for those radical fanatics, you will be depressed. People with depression have a problem in sustaining or maintaining positive emotion.



Radicals and extremists are there in every Arab country. The Israeli extremists are also the worst on earth. They caused the escalating humanitarian crisis in Gaza. One and a half million Palestinians are squeezed into one of the most over crowded land on the planet. As Israel and Egypt maintain a total blockade against Gaza, the misery deepens day by day.

People are forced to live in poverty in a tiny slice of territory is a recipe for continued bitterness and radicalism. The International Community has to do something to lift the blockade. There is no real pressure applied neither on Israel nor on Hamas. Illegal settlement activity in the west bank continues. Under Hamas rule, Gaza is going through a process of dedevelopment which could lead to the complete breakdown of public infrastructure.

Arab leaders neither want to do something about the suffering of people of Gaza nor about the global warming. They went on with a drama of accusing big nations for polluting the environment and asking for emission cuts with less constructive work from their side, when they make a mess everywhere by flying large private Jets, driving big cars, wasting food and overusing water and electricity by living in Huge houses that they do not need.

Qatari nationals cannot fill the 10000 jobs offered by Doha International Airport. Qatari nationals are being given a low quality education in Arabic schools with a curriculum of an overdose of culture, customs and traditions on the expense of English, Maths and Science. Billions of Riyals are being spent on foreign students in Qatar foundation while only smaller money is being spent on Qatari students in Qatar University. The



Qatarisation policy is not working effectively because our children are being brain washed in primary and secondary Arabic schools and then they end up being with some radical extremists teachers in Qatar University. That

kind of Qatari graduates Doha Airport does not want. They need open minded graduates like Hassan Aljefairi.

If Qatar wants to reduce the number of workers being imported from foreign countries, then it has to build up a manpower equivalent to Hassan Aljefairi the owner of the website www.hassanaljefairi.com the voice of the Qatari democracy.

Qatar will continue importing qualified Asian workforce until they have many Jefairies with proficiency in English, bachelor of commerce in Economics equipped with a membership in the Institute of marketing in Maidenhead in England and a membership in the American Management Association in Brussells. A national cadre consists of many Hassans.

The Qatarisation policy will work only if they enroll thousands of Qatari children in International schools teaching with English curriculum where children can also learn drama, arts, music and practice sports.

#### **21-12-2009**

If the Doha Debates team members are serious about employing innovative strategies to increase public engagement with its program, then why they isolate Hassan Aljefairi and try to stop him talking? Is not he the Qatari national, the grandson of a Qatari seafarer Mohammed Aljefairi, the great grandson of famous pearl



merchant Hassan Ibrahim Almulla Aljefairi and the grandson of the well known captain Mohammed Aljefairi. Hassan is also the grandson of Khalil Albaker the owner of the well known Qatari ship "Boat" called Fateh Alkhair.

The Doha debates are bringing their communication skills to share them with foreigners in Qatar. There are not much Qatari nationals want to attend their debates. I saw some foreigners wearing traditional Qatari dress, perhaps to cheat audience to make them think that these foreigners are Qatari nationals. I saw some Qatari official attending to make the government shine, but Qatari students are either asked or forced by their teachers to attend the Doha debates.

The Doha Debates team tried for the last few sessions to stop me talking in the debates. They also refused filming me lately for youtube page and for live blogging via twitter. Their team wants to enable the public to keep track of the government issues but not Hassan Aljefairi's issues.

Since the new management of the Doha Debates came, Aljefairi could not talk any more. It is not a fantastic opportunity to be with some of these team members as it seems to me that some questions are prepared for some persons in advance. The last time when I saw Tim Sebestian, I told him, he was the voice of the Government, while I was the voice of the Qatari people. I have not seen professional journalists, what I saw were some drummers playing the tune of Governments. Some good experienced journalists were there, but representing foreign media, they have shown a lot of respect to Hassan Aljefairi and offered to interview me.



#### 24-12-2009

If the Government does not listen to its citizen, the Qatari activist Hassan Aljefairi who is calling to make Qatar a free country, open minded and able to issue visas for thousands of single girls to come to work in here, then quality labor will not come to work in Qatar anymore and skilled technicians will leave Doha soon, then we will not be able to maintain high quality small and medium enterprises, we shall be unable to promote non

oil industries in the region and our strategies to diversify the economy will fail. Qatar has to choice either make а conservative Taliban like religious style of life or to choose Hassan Aljefairi who could create a high demand for business space in Qatar.



Any support to Aljefairi from the Government side will be a clear message to investors at home and abroad that following the financial crisis, Qatar has learnt not to depend on Oil and Gas only, but is to be open and free country attracting millions of tourists, investors and quality labor.

Hassan Aljefairi is 54, had served as Area Manager of Gulf Air in Qatar and now he is a prominent businessman. He is Qatar born and bred and though not a royal, belongs to a long- established merchant family "Aljefairi and Albaker" in Qatar.

After graduating in economics from Beirut Arab University in 1976, he rose through the Gulf Air ranks. He is an activist in Human rights and environment. His long line of experience in trading and in the financial security market had helped him to tackle and write about the fall out property market suffered during the downturn in a more transparent manner. With the dull situation here in Hotels and the entertainment industry, business needs the Qatari liberal Hassan Aljefairi who has a lot of experience and knowledge. He became well known without propaganda. Aljefairi has the capability.

The reshuffle last many years that did not keep other nationals, kept him appearing everyday as an activist and as a writer.



Many say that Aljefairi is Qatar's investment

arm whom without, economy can go wrong. Hassan Aljefairi's record is clean of the accusations of corruption that have overshadowed the reputation of other politicians in other developing countries, and he is trusted by the Qatari ruler, that is why he is given more space than some others. He is also trusted by the Qataris themselves. Why Aljefairi suddenly became the voice of the Qatari democracy does not need a long time to discover, it is easily because he is honest, faithful and sincere to the Qatari people. Any one of you wants to work hard as much as Aljefairi does, sure he will get the same support.

But one day, who knows, someone could call for the opposition leader Hassan Aljefairi to face trial for spreading big lies of lack of free media and freedom of speech in Qatar.

Aljefairi, the opposition figure says that we are not all equal towards the law, that opportunities are not for all and better quality of education is given to others but not to Qatari children, therefore the authorities reject the charge and maybe one day they believe that I should face trial in a court of law.

Other Government officials can also call one day for some actions against Aljefairi who is accused for encouraging protests among people. Oppositions in Gulf GCC countries are warned against staging illegal rallies.

#### Thursday December 24 2009, 11.00

Food is dearer in Qatar despite deflation, not due to the shortage of supply, but because of the misuse by some who do not care about the sufferings of others somewhere else in this world, or could be due to the overuse of food by dumping big quantities of rice and meat on wide metal round trays that will end



up in the dustbin end of the day. When Hassan Aljefairi wrote to stop these practices, the Qatari media and local press boycotted his pen and hidden his values.

Top GCC award was given to two Qatari websites, but my web www.hassanaljefairi.com was not awarded because it contained my words related to power sharing and my threat to the Government that I would boycott the next Parliamentary elections unless they reduce the number of voting districts in Qatar to five districts.

#### Thursday December 24 2009, 12.00

I love the Irani people. Irani nationals are great and kind, but the Irani Government sends its security forces to beat the Irani liberals friends of Hassan Aljefairi and use teargas against them.

Police clash with the opposition, arrest the injured demonstrators and hit them with sticks. Backers of opposition and liberal journalists are being surrounded, beaten and arrested. Liberals, protesters including women and children are beaten with chains and stones, but these brave Iranis continued to shout slogan against top authorities.

Despite arrests and security crackdowns, liberals, friends of Hassan Aljefairi protest repeatedly saying anti-government slogans. Motorists supported to



protest the security forces of bad treatment demonstrators.

Foreign media are banned from reporting directly on protests, but my friends reported the incidents on the opposition websites.

This Irani government is promoting the nuclear program to have military ends, not just civilian purposes.

I Hassan Aljefairi criticize the mass execution of the brave Irani men that were kept prisoner by the Irani police. Irani nationals have to choose either a religious state that might end up like Taliban who blow up girls schools or a modern state that has educated citizens like Hassan.

Taliban and their supporters are destroying educational institutions. That is exactly what will happen in Qatar when the Government makes Aljefairi fail

and makes Taliban win.



I warned in many cases that unless Qatar Government gives me enough support, then I threatened to quit and stop campaigning.

I would resign and refuse to sit together with some fanatics that want to issue visas only for men to work in Qatar, separate men from women and force ladies to stay at home.

#### 25-12-2009, 5:30 a.m.

Some use Islamic religion to gain money and power and call themselves Islamists. They control towns and parts of the capital in Somalia. They fight government troops and African Union peace keepers to impose their own version of Shariah against others but not against themselves, their relatives and their friends. They make more money and gain



extra power by using Islam to impose their rule throughout Somalia. Some call themselves Shebab and some use other names.

Different rebel groups were former allies but then broke fighting each other heavily over who should have the control of port, areas and resources. Their work is similar to Mafia's and they act like pirots, it has nothing to do with religion, they

storm buildings belonging to Aid Agencies. They loot equipments belong to relief organizations. Many Somalis are traditionally moderate Muslims and do not want these gangs. Violence on shore has extended to lawlessness at sea where other pirate gangs have received millions of dollars in ransoms for ships that they hijacked. Gangs everywhere together with the crooks use Islam to steal, pirate, kill and loot belongings of others. Attacks in waters will become rarer if more nations agree to start their navies patrolling in the area. Pirate groups will shift their focus to the wider Indian Ocean, but we can still find them in the huge sea through International Joint Cooperation using advances technology.

#### 25-12-2009, 6:15 a.m.

Hassan Aljefairi a Qatari writer can be held at any time. He can be questioned by public prosecutor. A law suit can be politically motivated against him. He can be questioned on charges of abusing Government officials and Ministers. If a writer criticizes the Ministers and their mismanagement and call on influential Minister to quit, he can be questioned and held.



#### 25-12-2009, 6:35 a.m.

I have not been allowed to enter some Aviation forums that are held related to environment.

Some know about my stand related to climate and emission reduction by the aviation industry. I insist to use new types of Aircrafts with a new technology that can help to make a major cut of the CO<sub>2</sub> emission. I also supported Shell and Rolls- Royce in their efforts to operate Gas to liquid flights.

Aviation officials do not like Hassan Aljefairi, because he is asking Governments to impose penalties against each flight operates with a small load factor whether

passengers or cargo. Also private wide bodied aero planes cannot fly any more with 4 or 6 passengers e.g. or with few kilogram's of cargo, Aljefairi insisted. It is their money, but it is our Air, he said.

#### 25-12-2009, 7:00 a.m.

Somalia's gangs Alshabab who have nothing to do with Islam ordered men to grow long beards and wear their trousers above the ankle. Somalis has lacked a functioning central government since 1991, that is why these illiterates were able to spread with stolen guns to focus on men's appearance, having previously ordered women to cover all their bodies, and banned bras, the same



illiterates, kill, lie, steal, misuse of power, pirating and looting belongings of others. Residents hate them as they see dead bodies and people killed. Kenya also hates them and therefore closed its border and boosted patrols to isolate those illiterates.

#### 25-12-2009, 11:00 a.m.

In one of the seminars in Doha, I said to the Pakistani nationals that if they choose Hassan Aljefairi, then the Pakistani economy will make important gains, their inflation will be reduced and International community will support their efforts, but I warned them that if they vote for radicals who finance Al Qaeda and Taliban, then they will ask for loans from The International Monetary Fund "IMF", their budgets will face huge deficits, they will face problems with militants who will make thousands of their people displaced by the struggle and will rely on the Government for food and shelter. I told them to observe the Indians when they decided to become friends of Hassan Aljefairi, their stability was restored, their

economy enjoyed a good growth and their political system was the best democracy in Asia. If the Pakistanis choose Aljefairi, they will be able to maintain peace amid political turbulence, cut down their inflation rate and stabilize their economy.

#### 25-12-2009, 1:30 p.m.

Many years ago, I spoke out in many occasions that Christians should have the right to build churches in Qatar, because we Muslims can build mosques in western countries.

At that time, no one had the courage to speak like this here in any GCC countries, because societies were strict conservative and small. Now, I feel that I played an important role to make Christians able to have the second Christmas Eve mass held at the new church.

I did not attend the inauguration day early 2008, but when I saw the coverage in the press, I felt my role that I played since many years ago.

Now, I have to remind the Christians of my role, because I need their support in the Press and Media when I campaign for the future Qatari Parliamentary elections. Most of the worshippers who go to the church have no knowledge about me. It is the church's responsibility to educate them about Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari man of peace who does not have


any discrimination against any one, any religion, any color or race, because Hassan knows how to love but does not know how to hate. If Aljefairi gets angry now, he will forget about it tomorrow, unable even to remember what his anger was about.



#### 25-12-2009, 2:00 p.m.

Qatar launched the mandatory pre-marital tests that aim to prevent the spread of genetic diseases, but I believe that abnormalities diseases are created from marrying relatives.

Qatar has one of the highest percentages of children with special needs in the world due to marrying relatives. That is why I asked for coeducation in Qatar University so that boys and girls can understand each other and marry.



That is much better than having arranged marriage between families causing a less healthy future generation.

If Qatar University does not cooperate with Hassan Aljefairi, arranged marriage will continue between two people who do not know each other then they will fight and divorce, this is the reason why we have the one of the highest rate of Divorce in the world 36%.

Premarital health screening will not help, only Hassan Aljefairi alone can write and speak what is the best for Qatari people. If the Qatari Press and media cooperate and publish everything Hassan writes, and say, percentage of inherited diseases will be reduced and more people can live happier.

#### 25-12-2009, 8:00 p.m.

The Saudi Government has waived the lashing a court ordered against a woman for working at a Lebanese television channel that aired a sexual

confessions program, but the Ministry of Justice did not drop the lashing against other persons. This woman is a journalist, therefore her story had a big coverage that embarrassed the Saudi authorities and made them drop the lashing, but there are so many others that not much people know about them.



Being a journalist, media reported her story putting pressure on Saudi Government that decided to transfer her case to the Ministry of Information. This proves that my claim is correct when I accused some

Arabic countries for using Islam to impose penalties against ordinary people, but important persons and officials can escape.

Saudi airline sales clerk Mazen was convicted of offensive behavior and sentenced to five years in jail and 1000 lashes for his appearance on the LBC show "Bold Red line", in which he talked about his private life. Three friends who appeared on the show with him were given two year prison terms and 300 lashes each, while a camera man who helped filming was sentenced to two months in jail, but those GCC influentials that we always hear and read their stories with prostitutes, drugs and gambling in Europe and U. S. A, no one dares to sentence them, putting them in jail or give them lashes.

Some influential persons in GCC countries have access to Alcohol, girl friends and hold private parties, but cannot be sentenced nor punished, while ordinary people can be put in jail and lashed easily.



#### 25-12-2009, 8:55 P.M

The Qatari healthcare system can be reformed and be paid for by fixing some of the most obvious inefficiencies and by preventing mistakes.

By attacking waste, we can reduce healthcare costs without affecting the quality of care or access to care.

One example. A paper-based system that discourages sharing of medical records accounts for 5 percent of amount overspending. It is waste when caregivers duplicate tests because results recorded in a patient's records with one provider are not available to another or when medical staff provide inappropriate treatment because relevant history of previous treatment cannot be accessed.

Unnecessary care such as the overuse of antibiotics and lab tests to protect against malpractice exposure makes up 37 percent of health care waste.

#### 29-12-2009, 5:20 a.m

Evaluation Institute announced School Report Cards. Card aimed at

strengthening communication between parents and Independent schools, but I am, Hassan Aljefairi, trying to promote the long day in schools. I want to keep Qatari children away from their families. Families in Qatar are more consumption oriented. Majority of



parents can read and write but they do not want to read. Only little attention is paid for caring about the children who are usually left with maids.

If a child can have a long day at school, that means he can join all the student activities, especially Arts, theatre, drama, painting, music and can practice sports, but at home, love for the child is there, but that love is not The family gathering involves more gossiping, jealousy and enough. sometimes hate between relatives, friends and neighbors.

It is much better to keep the Qatari child in a school enjoying Hassan AlJefairi's English curriculum learning Maths and Science in International Schools rather than keeping a child with his family learning nothing from them.

Someone said to me that sometimes ago in America or Australia or Newzeland, Governments took that native abused child away from his own native family and made him live in an educational Institute or somewhere where he could learn better, that is not exactly what I want to do with Qatari children, but I want to keep them as long as I can with American and British teachers. Why some think that I cannot do it, am I not Hassan Aljefairi, the activist who was the hammer on their head to build

International Schools in Qatar as a gift to the Qatari children to learn there, but on the contrary only very few were there.

Some Government officials instead of promoting and encouraging Qatari children to be enrolled to these English Schools, what they did was enrolling their own children to study in these schools and suggested to Qatari Citizens to keep their children in Arabic Schools, so they could have an overdose of traditions and customs on the expense of Maths and Science.

### 29-12-2009, 6:05 a.m.

I Hassan Al Jefairi, want to help the Qataris, my own people to move forward but some intelligence, somehow, somewhere are trying to stop me. Sometimes I feel that the Government together with the British, Americans and Europeans all united are to



discourage me to give Qatari children British Education, why? I do not know, but perhaps those expatriates do not want Qatari children to learn and replace them. Perhaps, the Government does not want to see a quality education given to Qatari children, because may be one day in the future they will talk like Hassan AlJefairi giving them a hard time every day, they want more share in the rule and asking for more political rights.

I am sure that with Hassan Al Jefairi's values, children can become the leaders of the future, to learn leadership in a school that prepares future leaders. Hassan AlJefairi's school focuses on Mathematics and Science which traditionally have failed in Qatar and elsewhere in the Arab world, but I was told one day, that despite of Jordan little economic resources,

Education in Jordan was rated as the number one in the Arab world. Oatar spends more money in Education among all GCC countries, but I was told that Kuwait was rated much better.

It is important to build schools and Universities in Qatar, but it is more important to teach Hassan AlJefair's values so you could graduate Qatari Engineers, Doctors, technicians, leaders and surgeons. I have read that so many Qatari students are not qualified to enter the Universities in Qatar Foundation, but very few were admitted due to lack of quality level to enter Universities that are modelled on a similar universities built in U.S. that cost Qatar billions of rivals, but a lot of Qatari students deprived from the right to study in an academy that was built with their own money.

I want nothing from the Qataris except one thing is that one day when they have money, after my death, is to fund American or English modeled schools carrying my name in Africa and Asia for the poor children.

After my death, I also want the Qataris to print books about Hassan Al

jefairi's long journey fighting for freedom of expression and love, to make films about his mission in promoting the protection of personal freedom and make a documentary describing his love/hate letter to Qatari Government urging them to give more personal freedoms to young generation that




is frustrated, especially when a teenage boy and a girl want to talk, but they cannot talk, it is not the culture, but it is the ignorance of some who want my Qatari people to remain backward.

### <u>29-12-2009, 7:15 A.</u> M

I am Hassan Aljefairi, the Gandhi of Qatar, I want to see changes happening through peaceful means, I do not want to see riots in Qatar reveal anger of a generation that see no improvement in their daily living conditions. That is why I am talking hard about giving quality education to our children, because if these children grow and be unemployed, then these young men will throw rocks and bottles at police, because they will be fed up of waiting for the Government to give them jobs.

Police efforts to split the rioters by tear gas and pumped water will fail. The deepest problem will be the anger and frustration that will be felt by thousands of Qatari young men and women who are deprived from the right of enjoying personal freedom, happiness and love in an energy producing country. They will accuse the Government of letting them down.

This frustration will be growing, you can feel it in the road, when young



men speed, take your way, jump on your line and pass red traffic lights. When people see growth jumping ending the economic slump, then they will believe that Hassan Aljefairi is the oxygen of freedoms in Qatar whom without democracy dies. Then, it is the time to boost credit to small business and encourage firms to offer jobs.

you need Hassan Aljefairi's ideas more than needing the Governments stimulus packages. They are making ill-considered decisions by isolating me from press and media, particularly at a time when our resources become limited.

Government should immediate becomes open to my good ideas and to take my steps to put Qatar forward towards modernization, that is what Hassan Aljefairi hopes to achieve in his mission.



The losses will be in billions if my advice is not taken, some will face bankruptcy, it will be a difficult and challenging time, a lot will be disappointed and upset at what is going to happen. Press was able to isolate me, but this lead me to a situation that I can write my own books and never sign a way my mind property.

I have a control over my own life, that is what is happening to me now, but I am still the best citizen Qatar could ever have, a total support writing and talking every day for the best of my people. Why not, who could ever dare

### 31-12-2009, 5:30 a.m.

I am not welcome any more to environmental seminars being Hassan Aljefairi, the Qatari activist. I insisted that Qatar should unveil a carbon target to cut green house gas emissions from Human activities. Qatar has to adhere to a goal to cut the amount of carbon dioxide per each unit of national income by 50% by 2020.

This is a voluntary action suggested by Hassan Aljefairi as a major contribution to the global effort in tackling climate change. If the Qatari


# 31, December, 2009 6.45am.

Cyber criminals had attacked my website more than twice. I am expecting more successful assaults from those enemies of Hassan Aljefairi, the man of love and peace.

# 3, January, 2009 7a.m.

I am always writing about inequalities in Qatar. More foreign students enjoy access to good quality education in International English speaking schools. These schools are subsidized and financed with Qatar public money. Some few Qatari children are there, but they are the sons and daughters of some Government officials. Those officials are the same ones who stand in conferences and seminars urging Qataries to send their children to Arabic schools.

Access to good quality education is only for some but not for all. More than 90% of Qatari children are in Arabic schools learning an overdose of culture, traditions and customs. Good quality English education should be forced on more Qatari groups in order to bridge the gaps.

There should also be research policies focusing on how an overdose customs, traditions and religions teaching by some radical teachers can affect education badly in Arabic Qatari schools.



Qatar needs to create thousands of jobs every year and without enrolling more Qatari children to English Schools, there will be more graduates that are not needed by the labour market. We do not have poor Qatari people, our country is the richest and we have a small

population of 250,000 Qatari nationals only, so there is no excuse for the Government not to send thousands of Qatari children to English Schools. In addition to the English curriculum, our children can learn Arabic, History and Islam, but the progress is very limited, despite of the fact that Hassan AlJefairi's writing and fighting every day. Qatari people should be inspired to work as a one community to support Aljefairi, but not to ignore him, it is the future of their children, it is their tomorrow's life. Children have the right to have a good future and a good life. While there are many programmes focusing on education, more Qatari students have no means to learn a good English language as more of them cannot pass neither the tofel test nor the lower Cambridge English test. Arabic education standard remains low, though access to English Schools has to improve.

Qatar foundation's policies must stress on equality and access. It should look into the problem of having less Qatari students in good Universities like Weill cornell. These Universities work with our Qatari money. Some say that Weill Cornell alone costs one million riyals a day. It is a shame that despite of the fact that we spent billions of riyals and in the end of six years work, then we are able only to graduate 4 Qatari Doctors out of 40 graduates. Last ceremony, we graduated 2 doctors out of 19 graduates. This is a very small number. We need 3000 doctors for Hamad Hospital, not two, but who cares for Qatar other than its son Hassan AlJefairi who writes and talks for free.



Differences and variations in educational systems and policies have been found in Qatar. They have a huge impact on the low scores obtained by Qatari students in International competitive examinations,

specially of those studying in Arabic Government and Independent Schools.

Even within the schools in one country like Qatar, performances may vary based on educational policies and teaching methods, that is why English schools achieved good scoring. This was explained based on the results of exams taken by thousands of students in Qatar.

Education policy, Hassan AlJefairi like, has to care for Qatari children since their early childhood. More investment should be made for attaching Qatari children to English speaking curriculum International Schools like Qatar Academy, Doha College, Sherborne, Debakey, American, London Schools ,...etc.



# 5, January, 2010, 6 a.m.

Foreign expatriates should support Hassan AlJefairi with his mission to introduce high quality education by attaching more Qatari children to English speaking schools, because that will make a strong economy in the future for Qatar which means more job opportunities for expatriates. Foreigners should also support Hassan AlJefairi in his efforts to modernize Qatar, for example by separating men from women, like what is happening in Qatar University, this leads graduate students to marry relatives which means more genetic diseases, diabetes and continuous rise on noncommunicable diseases.



Co-education in Qatar University where boys and girls can mix and study together will reduce marriages between close relatives among Qataris as 43% of women who marry are

found to be close relatives to their husbands.

# 5, January, 2009, 6:45 a.m.

Education spending per capita increased but most of it goes to foreign students in Qatar foundation and International Schools. The spending in Qatar University and Arab Schools is less.

The growing education spending per capita should be for all Qatari students but not for a small percentage of Qatari students or for a majority of foreign students. I am Hassan Aljefair, I do not discriminate against foreign students, but I am only asking to give our Qatari children the same opportunity that is given to foreign students so they can all learn together sharing happiness with peace and love.



No real development can be achieved with a widening gap whether in favor of European students or Qatari students. The gap is there in the curriculum in terms of the teaching methods as well as

the theoretical approaches. Hassan Aljefairi opposes the overdose of culture and customs values given to our Qatari children in Qatari schools. They are given more religious teachings on the expense of maths, science and English language. Boys are forced to wear the traditional dress as a uniform, it is a long robe with a cloth on the head. This was rejected by Hassan Aljefairi as it prevents children to play, run and move freely.

Hassan Aljefairi wants co-education to be introduced in Qatari primary schools where Boys and girls up to 10 years old can mix and study together in one school. This will create more respect and understanding between males and females. Children in Qatari schools are not playing sports efficiently, sports is there in the curriculum. Hassan Aljefairi was the hammer on their heads to make sports a subject in the curruculum and a must with marks, children can fail or pass, but despite of all my efforts, sports subject is being ignored in most of our Qatari schools, that is why we have arise in life-style related diseases like diabetes and heart diseases.

Reduced physical activity among our Qatari students due to the national dress that they are being forced to wear, causing obesity and gaining more



weight. Children are also eating unhealthy food due to the fact that Hassan Aljefairi cannot appear in the media and the press to educate them about the healthy diet, he can tell them what to eat. More fruits, salads and vegetables together with less grilled fish and little rice or bread. Qatar cannot produce one Hassan Aljefairi every day, but once every one hundred years.



Television channels and press also seen having were as influenced the Qatari people to put their children away from the English speaking international schools. Unemployment result from this attitude in the future and instability can be there. Businessmen and investors are losing billions of dollars while economy is under

pressure from the Government media to close this country, isolates Hassan Aljefairi, issue more strict rules, limit freedoms and direct the media to support extremists.

Women must be discouraged in universities and Government departments in Qatar from wearing the full veil, known as a burga or nigab. I am totally opposed to the burga. The wearing of the full veil reflects a shift away from Hassan Aljefairi type of moderate Islam. This behavior is to be discouraged in all public and private sector offices.

Suicide bombings blamed on the extremists have soared in the past few years. Some terrorists hide under the full veil to commit their crimes.

# 8, January, 2010, 8.00 am

I, Hassan Aljefairi if one day gain political power, shall not allow Qatar's territory to be used by terrorists. I shall not invite trouble by allowing foreign extremists to enter Qatar and use its territories for carrying out terrorism in another country.

I would travel to attend summit talks where co-operation against terrorism especially with U.S.A, U.K. and France. I have always complained against media in Qatar giving space to extremists to justify the crimes of the terrorists.
